

# Texas Fraternal Congress Invites high school seniors to apply for scholarship



Established in 1948, the purpose of the Texas Fraternal Congress (TFC) is to coordinate the statewide outreach efforts of Fraternal Benefit Societies in Texas in cooperation with the National Fraternal Congress of America. The TFC Scholarship Program is intended to recognize commitment to the fraternal ideal and to encourage and assist graduating seniors in furthering their education and helping them to achieve career goals. Two scholarships in the amount of \$200 each will be awarded to graduating high school seniors belonging to the following fraternal benefit societies: Catholic Family Fraternal of Texas (KJZT), Catholic Life, Catholic Union of Texas (KJT), SPJST, Grand Court Order of Calanthe, Knights of Columbus, Order of the Sons of Hermann, Thrivent for Lutherans, Western Fraternal Life, Woodmen of the World. Scholarship recipients may only be awarded one scholarship from TFC. Scholarships will be presented in the spring of 2010.

## **Eligibility Requirements**

TFC scholarship applicants must:

- Be classified as a high school graduating senior or equivalent at the time of application.
- Have an active fraternal life insurance certificate in force for at least one year prior to January 1 of the year in which the scholarship is being applied.
- Enter college in the fall term following the announcement of their award.
