Project Ideas

- 1. Build wheelchair ramps.
- 2. Hold a clothing drive.
- 3. Deliver/Serve meals.
- 4. Hold food drive.
- 5. Collect old cell phones for soldiers.
- 6. Hold a toy drive for children (during Christmas)
- 7. Collect and deliver Turkey's during Thanksgiving.
- 8. Collect blankets & winter coats
- 9. Community cleanup projects (parks, roadside, etc.).
- 10. Hold a Back to School supplies or backpack drive.
- Help "Beat the Heat" by collecting fans to be distributed to those in need (summer months).
- 12. Coordinate & collect items for soldiers.
- 13. Collect books for local library or book bank.
- 14. Host a blood drive.
- Coordinate & host fire safety class & demonstration.
- 16. Establish a nursing home or assisted living visitation program.
- 17. Read to the elderly program.

- 18. Organize an after school tutor program.
- 19. Hold a T-shirt to blanket drive
- 20. Make tie-together blankets for those in need and/or homeless.
- 21. Church landscaping or grounds clean up.
- 22. Host a basic personal finance class.
- 23. Start a local garden to benefit a food pantry.
- 24. Organize & coordinate service to help elderly go grocery shopping or run errands.
- 25. Place flags at Veterans' graves.

- 27. Community garage sale with proceeds going to charity.
