## **Hurricane Harvey Relief Fund**

Please continue to keep the victims of Hurricane Harvey in your prayers. While the hurricane is long gone, the effects of the damage that plagued much of the Gulf Coast and parts of Central Texas will be felt for years to come. The KJT Board of Directors has authorized a matching fund of \$5,000 for the Hurricane Harvey Victims in Texas. To date, we have already collected \$7,520 as I write this so the total donation to date is \$12,520 as we have already

met the \$5,000 match total. The funds collected will be distributed through Catholic Charities.
